Introduction

This never-before-broadcast simulcast offers a chance to remember Nabeel and relive his story anew. Along with Mark Mittelberg and Lee Strobel, Nabeel discusses how to love our Muslim neighbors well. We hope this discussion guide helps you and your community dwell on the concepts discussed during the program.

The simulcast is a companion conversation to Nabeel's bestselling memoir, *Seeking Allah, Finding Jesus*. For those who have not read *Seeking Allah, Finding Jesus*, Nabeel describes his dramatic journey from Islam to Christianity, complete with friendships, investigations, and supernatural dreams along the way. Providing an intimate window into a loving Muslim home, he shares how he developed a passion for Islam before discovering, almost against his will, evidence that Jesus rose from the dead and claimed to be God. Unable to deny the arguments but not wanting to deny his family, Qureshi struggled with an inner turmoil that will challenge Christians, Muslims, and all those who are interested in the world's greatest religions.

We hope this simulcast presentation both challenges and encourages you as you seek to reach your neighbors with the Gospel.

About Nabeel

Nabeel Qureshi was the author of the *New York Times* bestsellers *No God But One* and *Seeking Allah, Finding Jesus*—the only book ever to win Christian Book Awards for both “Best New Author” and “Best Nonfiction.” Nabeel was an accomplished global speaker and held an MD from Eastern Virginia Medical School, an MA in Christian apologetics from Biola University, an MA in religion from Duke University, and an MPhil in Judaism and Christianity from Oxford University.

Following a year-long battle with stomach cancer, heaven welcomed Nabeel home on September 16, 2017. He leaves behind his wife and young daughter who aspire to honor the ministerial legacy Nabeel established during his brief 34 years on earth.

Nabeel's Story

1. How deeply have you explored the Christian faith to be able to answer the questions of your neighbor?

2. In what ways have you sought to build relationship with your neighbors with whom you would like to share the gospel?

3. David Wood was a longsuffering friend to Nabeel who was passionate for truth. How might you build faithful friendships with non-believing people in your life?

4. Who did God place in your life to walk with you and help you come to a place where you were ready to enter a life-changing relationship with Jesus? What were some things this person did to help you along on your spiritual journey?

5. Unpack what Nabeel says, “Fear doesn’t make sense as a Christian response.” How might the truth of this impact your evangelism?

6. How might you find common ground with friends of different religions? How might that common ground open doors?

7. What are some things that can get in the way of our engaging fully with people who are not yet followers of Jesus? What steps can we take to connect more meaningfully and consistently with the non-believing people God places in our lives?

8. Why is hospitality so pivotal in our relationships with non-believing people? How might you extend hospitality in an intentional way?

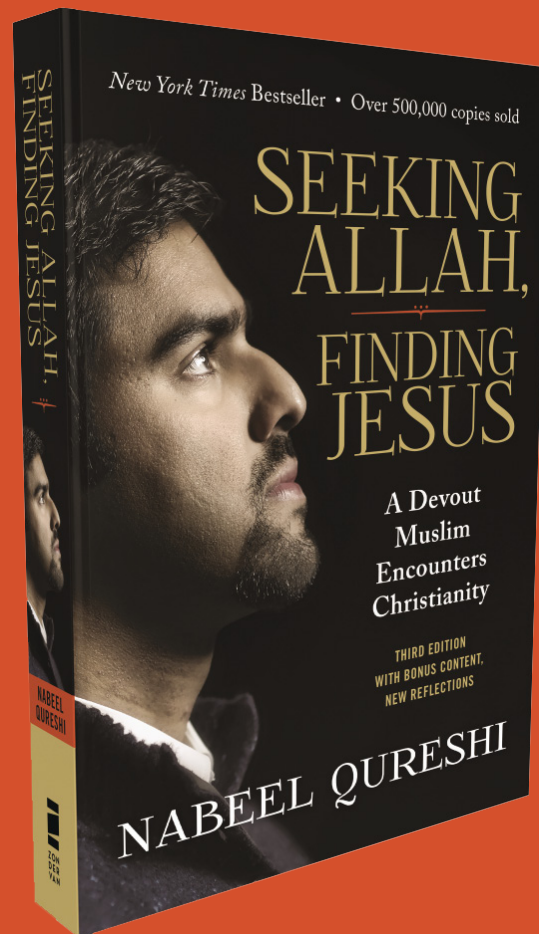
